- Identify the source
- Determine objectivity or viewpoint
- Ascertain reliability





Identify the source

- Is the text attributed to an **author?**
- Does the site have a "about us" page?
- Who owns the publisher or platform?
 - Check SDAT business entity search

Is it "sponsored content"

- "Paid post"
- "Presented by"
- "Sponsored by"
- "Partnered with"
- "Promoted"
- "Affiliated with"
- "Powered by"






Objectivity or viewpoint

- What kinds of ads are on the page?
- What types of sites are linked to?
- Do authors have credentials?
 - Google the author
 - Check for a Linked-In page



Reliability

- Does the page state when it was **last amended**?
- What is the **topic**?
 - Compare interestingengineering.com and justice.org
- Are there feedback mechanisms?
- Active deceit vs. stale content
 - Domain names are unreliable indicators. Anyone can get a <u>.gov</u> or .org domain



Search operators and limits

- "phrase searching"
- Connectors: OR, minus sign (-)
- Document format (filetype:)

Domain / site restriction

- .org, .edu, .gov
- Or restrict to full site

Google Scholar (scholar.google.com)

- Wide range of case law with basic citator
- Scholarly articles (if within Judiciary network, links to Library databases like HeinOnline)
